THE ANNUAL "SILVER MIGRATION" FRIENDS+FISH=FUN!

It's that time again! The fishing rally is set for
May, 16-23, 2017. and spaces are going fast!

This year we will be returning to a long time favorite of the WBCCI Washington Unit, Black Beach Resort located in beautiful Republic, WA. Every year in May, the "silver migration" always makes its way east to the land of sun, mountains and the cool spring waters of high elevation lakes. The "silver migration" will line up on May 15, 2017 at 10:00 am across from Harmony Hall for those who wish to travel in caravan fashion. We will be leaving Harmony Hall at 10:30 am. The "silver migration" will be following the historic route of their predecessors. The beauty of the "silver migration" will travel over Tiger Mountain Summit on Hwy 18E, with its first resting point at North Bend where the migration can refuel and rest for an hour. Once restored, the "silver migration" will continue over Hwy 97N towards Wenatchee where it will rest for the night at Beebe Bridge Park located 34 miles north of Wenatchee on Hwy 97. Beebe Bridge is a first come first served park and has always had room in the past for the weary "silver migration". After such a long and grueling migration, there is no more need to hurry. The migration only has about a 2 hour journey ahead so this is the perfect morning to sleep in or spend time checking your tackle. The "silver migration" will depart towards Tonasket and then on to Republic at 11:00 am (don't want to arrive before check-in). Once there you can sit in the shade of your favorite tree or if you're like me, hit the water and start searching for the trophy winning Rainbow!



This year's rally is only \$375 for a couple and \$350 for singles leaving plenty of \$\$ for new gear or maybe go out to dinner with your favorite co-pilot.
