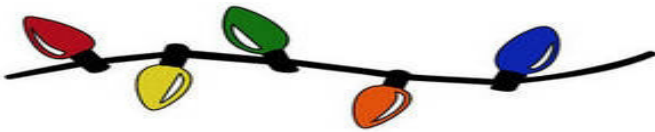

Filtered Light



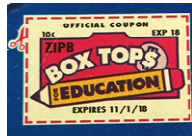
